Freedom of the City; or Canvassing for a local charity. *le:* The United Way, SPCA, etc. m. 3. Instructions for Directing Staff: To find out how you can participate in any of these events or activities

contact the event/activities coordinating body who will give you the necessary information.

- 4. Whenever you participate in a community activity, make sure that you publicize the event or activity. This will show everyone the important work that your squadron does in the community. Publicity will also aid in the recruitment of new cadets as they will be able to see some of the things that the squadron does.
- 5. If your squadron has photography equipment, or knows a photographer, have that person take lots of pictures. It gives you a record of the event as well as pictures to use for your annual recruiting drive, ACR, etc.
